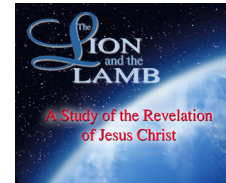
IMPACT

Facebook Live Prayer and Devotional

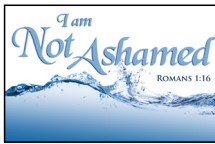

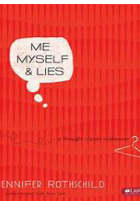


WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY, STARTING SEPTEMBER 3 @ 12:00 PM
