LUKE 14:1-24

*<sup>1</sup> It happened that when He went into the house of one of the leaders of the Pharisees on the Sabbath to eat bread, they were watching Him closely. <sup>2</sup> And there in front of Him was a man suffering from dropsy. <sup>3</sup> And Jesus answered and spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath, or not?" <sup>4</sup> But they kept silent. And He took hold of him and healed him, and sent him away. <sup>5</sup> And He said to them, "Which one of you will have a son or an ox fall into a well, and will not immediately pull him out on a Sabbath day?" <sup>6</sup> And they could make no reply to this.*

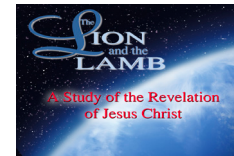
### WEDNESDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES - 6:00 - 7:30 PM

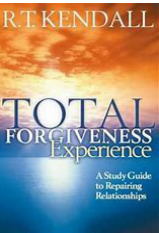


### LADIES BIBLE STUDY, Tuesdays @ 12:00 PM
